- A 60 year-old woman with a recent diagnosis of stage 4 cancer who was having anxiety and panic attacks
- A 10 year-old child exhibiting anxiety, worrying about whether he would get into college, the health of his parents, the well-being of his baby sister and wars in the world
- A firefighter with PTSD
- A father who became dependent on prescription medication following surgery. After counseling, he resumed life free of substances.

These people, and many others, are hungry for care and we need your assistance to help them. Your donation will allow us to continue serving the growing number of families who turn to Interfaith every year in need of counseling, emergency assistance and food. Thank you for your consideration.
