The success of our 5K event supports these sessions, and many others, for individuals who otherwise would not be able to afford treatment.

Here are some of the clients our New Directions' therapists began working with recently:

- A teenage girl who is trying to deal with her parents' hostile divorce. As a result, she is starting to have issues at school. She felt like she had no one to talk to before she began treatment with Interfaith's counseling center.
- A young father of three started drinking after losing his job. He is now in recovery and wants to do everything he can to stay healthy and find work.
- A 60-year-old woman was recently diagnosed with a
 disease which resulted in her near total loss of vision.
 She can no longer work and lost her job of 24 years.
 Interfaith's vision loss counseling specialist is working
 with her to help her adjust to her blindness and cope
 with the emotional and psychological ramifications of
 a such drastic life change.
- 8- and 6-year-old brothers lost their father. Their mother is so distraught she is having a hard time coping with and supporting them.
